## OUR ASSIGNMENT

TO RAISE UP THE ARK OF THE COVENANT OF THE PRESENCE OF (LORD) YHVH  
ACROSS THIS LAND.

TO RIDE HORSES ACROSS AMERICA FROM CALIFORNIA TO MARYLAND WORSHIPPING,  
PRAYING AND BLOWING THE SHOFAR, ANNOUNCING ALONG THE WAY THAT  
Y'SHUA IS COMING TO FILL HIS TEMPLE.

TO ARRIVE AT WA, D.C. TO ESTABLISH AND SET IN THE ARK OF HIS GOVERNMENT AS  
HE ORIGINALLY INTENDED.

**1Ki 8:1** Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the princes of the fathers' *houses* of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, to *bring up the ark of the covenant of Jehovah out of the city* of David, which is Zion.

**1Ki 8:2** And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the feast, in the month Ethanim, which is the seventh month. (September-October 2010)

**1Ki 8:3** And all the elders of Israel came, and the priests took up the ark.

**1Ki 8:4** And *they brought up the ark of Jehovah, and the tent of meeting, and all the holy vessels that were in the Tent; even these did the priests and the Levites bring up.*

**1Ki 8:5** And king Solomon and all the congregation of Israel, that were assembled unto him, were with him before the ark, sacrificing sheep and oxen, that could not be counted nor numbered for multitude.

**1Ki 8:6** *And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of Jehovah unto its place, into the oracle of the house, to the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubim.*

**1Ki 8:7** For the cherubim spread forth their wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubim covered the ark and the staves thereof above.

**1Ki 8:8** And the staves were so long that the ends of the staves were seen from the holy place before the oracle; but they were not seen without: and there they are unto this day.

**1Ki 8:9** There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone which Moses put there at Horeb, when Jehovah made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.

**1Ki 8:10** And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of Jehovah,

**1Ki 8:11** so that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud; for the glory of Jehovah filled the house of Jehovah. ASV

## AND SO THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL BROUGHT WHAT WAS NECESSARY TO BUILD THE TABERNACLE AND TO BRING IT FORTH:

**Exo 35:21** And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, *and* **brought Jehovah's offering, for the work of the tent of meeting, and for all the service thereof, and for the holy garments.**

**Exo 35:22** And they came, **both men and women, as many as were willing-hearted,** *and* brought brooches, and ear-rings, and signet-rings, and armlets, all jewels of gold; even every man that offered an offering of gold unto Jehovah.

**Exo 35:23** And every man, with whom was found blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' *hair*, and rams' skins dyed red, and sealskins, brought them.

**Exo 35:24** Every one that did offer an offering of silver and brass brought Jehovah's offering; and every man, with whom was found acacia wood for any work of the service, brought it.

**Exo 35:25** And all the women that were wise-hearted did spin with their hands, and brought that which they had spun, the blue, and the purple, the scarlet, and the fine linen.

**Exo 35:26** And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun the goats' *hair*.

**Exo 35:27** And the rulers brought the onyx stones, and the stones to be set, for the ephod, and for the breastplate;

**Exo 35:28** and the spice, and the oil; for the light, and for the anointing oil, and for the sweet incense.

**Exo 35:29** The children of Israel brought a freewill-offering unto Jehovah; every man and woman, whose heart made them willing to bring for all the work, which Jehovah had commanded to be made by Moses.

### Application

- a) OBSERVE the feasts of the (LORD) YHVH from Pesach (Passover) to Sukkot (Tabernacles)
- b) OBSERVE the LORD's Sabbaths – Holy to the Him
- c) ANNOUNCE that He is the true Sovereign and Judge in the Land
- d) Daily read and study his written Word, the Bible
- e) Continue in prayer and worship as we move onward each day both riders and ground support team
- f) Erect the Tabernacle or Tabernacle environment with or without the tent from place to place
